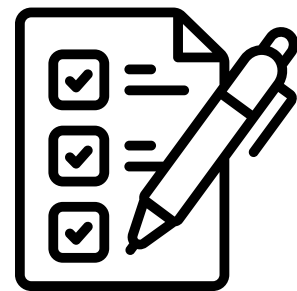


MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER

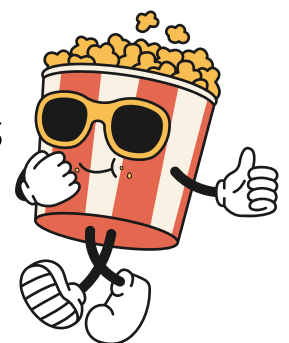

Anti-bullying Week

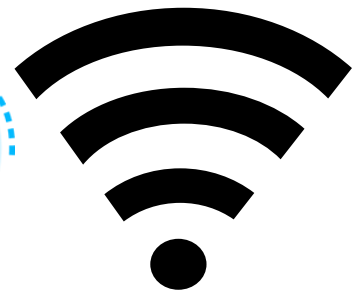

Freightliners Farm - Holly class

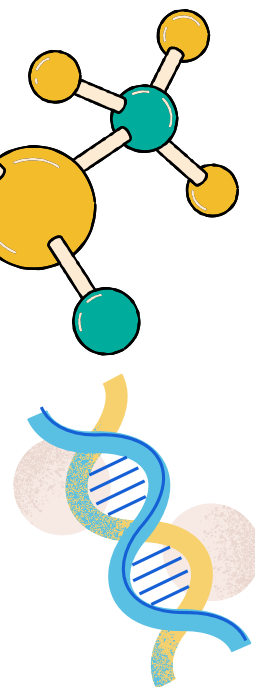
