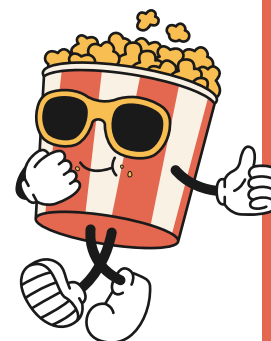

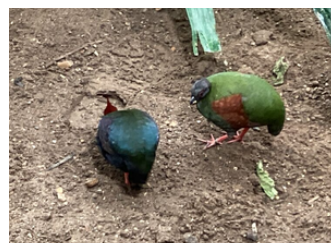
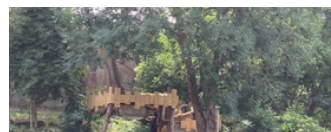
## Daily Mile and Dance Celebration Event
